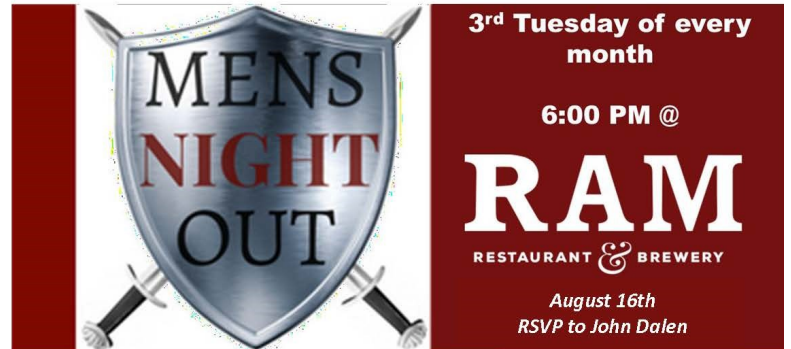
Thank you for the cards, notes and messages of healing. A special thank you to those who volunteered to shop and haul me around. My arm is healing. The prayers were appreciated.
